WATER USE

FIRST USE OF WATER IS THE BIOSPHERE OF SANTA MONICA MOUNTAINS. But, 95% of its water is captured in local aquifers and the San Gabriel River Watershed is source of water for homes and commercial facilities in dozens of cities and millions of people. Use of the San Gabriel Mountains and River as a national recreation area (among other federal designations) must be done in a way that doesn't reduce or threaten our water supplies.

HABITAT

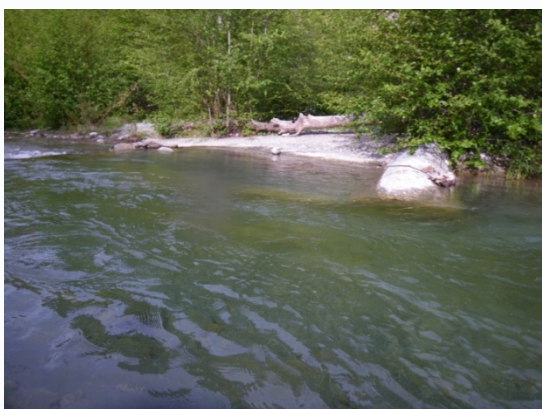
The mountains contain a high level of biodiversity. The San Gabriel Mountains provide habitat for 76 plant species and 77 wildlife species considered sensitive, rare, threatened and / or endangered. The San Gabriel Mountains are a rich area for freshwater fish species in Southern California.
